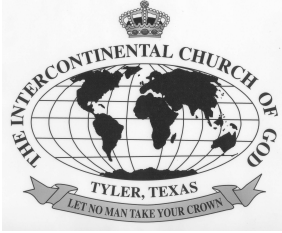

## FALL HOLY DAYS ARE ALMOST HERE!

### God's Holy Days 2011

*All Holy Days begin at sunset the evening before.*

September 29 – Feast of Trumpets

October 8 – Day of Atonement

October 13-19 - Feast of Tabernacles

October 20 – Last Great Day

The Intercontinental Church of God Kansas City holds services every Sabbath day (Saturday) at 11:30 AM at “The Pearl” meeting hall on the lower level. It is located at 13137 Wornall Road, Kansas City, MO 64145. Pull up the driveway on the left side of the building and park in the parking lot behind the building. Enter through the door in the back of the building. Do NOT use the front door as it is on the upper level and is normally locked. The rear door goes straight into our meeting room. The door will open by 11:00 AM and the service will begin promptly at 11:30 AM.

The first Sabbath of the month is a Bible study. It is conducted at the normal time. On the third Sabbath of each month, the service is followed by a potluck. All are invited.



In addition, this is the location for most of the Holy Day services for 2011, the exceptions being the Feast of Tabernacles and Last Great Day.

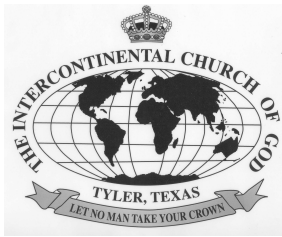

We will be back to weekly Sabbath Services October 22, 2011 at our local meeting place.

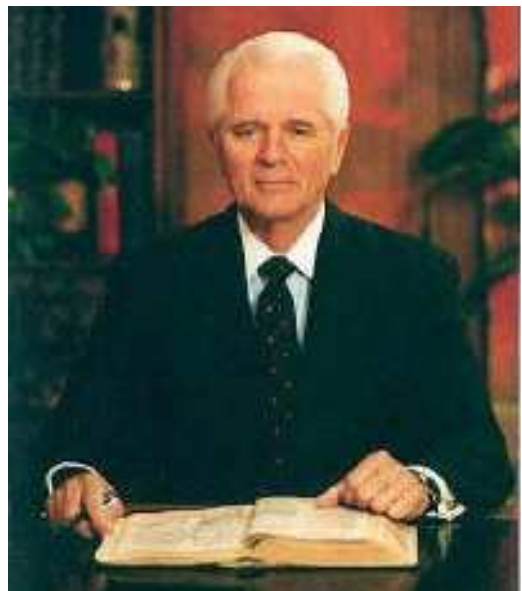
Special Thanks to Farris & Jean Fincher for their help as hosts for the local church group in Kansas City. We will miss the help, as things will keep Jean closer to home.
